

Extended information on the use of cookies

This website uses technical cookies to guarantee the correct functioning of the procedures and improve the experience of using online applications. This document provides information on use of cookies and similar technologies, on how they are used by the site and on how to manage them.

Definitions

Cookies are small text files that the sites visited by users send to their terminals, where they come from stored before being re-transmitted to the same sites on the next visit. Cookies of the so-called "third parties" instead, they are set by a website other than the one the user is visiting. This is because on each site may contain elements (images, maps, sounds, specific links to other web pages) domains, etc.) that reside on servers other than the one of the site visited.

Types of cookies

Based on the characteristics and use of cookies, we can distinguish several categories:

- Technical cookies. This site uses so-called "technical cookies", or small text files containing one certain amount of information exchanged between the Website and your terminal (or rather your browser terminal), which allow its correct functioning and use.

- Analytical cookies. This Website uses so-called "analytical cookies" made and made available by third parties, or **Google Analytics**. This happens for mere internal statistical analysis of access, per improve the Website and simplify its use, as well as to monitor its correct functioning. - Profiling cookies. Profiling cookies are aimed at creating profiles for the user and come used in order to send advertising messages in line with the preferences shown by the same in the context of web browsing. Because of the particular invasiveness that such devices can have in the private sphere of users, European and Italian legislation requires that the user should be adequately informed about their use and express their valid consent. The This site does not use profiling cookies.

"Third-party" cookies

By visiting this website you may receive cookies from sites managed by other organizations ("third parties"). An example is the presence of "social plugins" for Facebook, Twitter, Google+ or LinkedIn, or display systems for embedded multimedia content (integrated) such as Youtube, Flickr. These are parts generated directly by the aforementioned sites and integrated into the website page visited host. The presence of these plugins involves the transmission of cookies to and from all sites managed by third parties. The management of information collected by "third parties" is governed by the relative information that you should refer to. Analytics cookies

Duration of cookies

Some cookies (session cookies) remain active only until the browser is closed or executed of the possible logout command. Other cookies "survive" when the browser is closed and are available also in subsequent visits by the user. These cookies are called persistent and their duration is set by server at the time of their creation. In some cases a deadline is set, in other cases the duration is unlimited.

Cookie management

The user can decide whether to accept cookies using the settings on his browser. Attention: with the total or partial disabling of technical cookies it could compromise the use optimal site. Disabling "third party" cookies does not affect browsing in any way. The setting can be defined specifically for different websites and web applications. Also browsers allow you to define different settings for "owner" and "third-party" cookies. By way of example, in Firefox, through the menu Tools-> Options-> Privacy, it is possible to access a panel control where you can define whether to accept the different types of cookies and proceed with them removal.
